#### ah-Candle High Holiday Parking

When parking for the High Holidays at CBD or Aqua Blue, please respect our neighbor's property and that of Aqua Blue. The management of Aqua Blue has requested that we NOT park in the hotel's front parking lot located on Beach St. or in spaces that are reserved for Pier Village shopping. There is ample parking behind the hotel in the Pier Village or on the street.

CBD has enacted guidelines for parking at CBD. (Please refer to the parking guidelines on the last page of this newsletter). We have also made arrangements with the Ice House, located at the corner of Kingstown Rd. (one block from CBD) to use its parking lot during the High Holidays.

#### **Food Donations**

### Meet High Holidays Cantor Anita Schubert



CBD welcomes Cantor Anita Schubert who, as High Holidays Cantor, will co-lead our services with Rabbi Adler. Cantor Schubert grew up in Queens and Lynbrook, L.I. She received her bachelor's degree in education at the University of Rochester and a master's degree at the University of Maryland. Anita's interest in leading services developed in the late '80's, as women were able to enter that arena for the first time. After a few years of developing her skills, as well as teaching music and training b'nei mitzvah students for several local Hebrew schools, she felt that the cantorate was indeed the career she was meant to pursue.

Cantor Schubert did most of her cantorial and general music studies in the Washington, D.C. area. Between 1991 and 2001 she served several congregations ranging from Reform to Reconstructionist to Conservative in Bethesda and Columbia, MD; Ocean and Clifton, NJ; and Evanston, IL. From 2001-2015 she served Beth Sholom B'nai Israel, a Conservative synagogue in Manchester, CT. Currently she lives in south Florida and serves several congregations as a b'nei mitzvah instructor and teacher. She is a member of the Cantors Assembly and a past president of the Women Cantors' Network.
